Agentic Vertigo

With the emergence of agentic systems, a new chapter in the digital age is unfolding.

Systems no longer simply execute instructions: they perceive, reason, plan, and act. They interact with one another, make decisions, and modify their environments. Artificial intelligence is becoming an actor in its own right.

This transition creates a sense of vertigo.

Technological vertigo, first, as autonomous capabilities operate at unprecedented speed and scale. Then, organizational vertigo, as decision chains fragment across designers, operators, and users. Finally, strategic vertigo, as performance, security, and accountability must be constantly balanced.

In this new landscape, the role of humans is profoundly changing. Humans no longer validate every action in real time. They define rules, set boundaries, and supervise systems already in motion. They govern decision loops they no longer directly control.

In this context, cybersecurity itself must evolve.

The challenge is no longer limited to protecting systems or safeguarding data. It is about securing artificial entities capable of taking initiative and action. With them come new risks: objective hijacking, context manipulation, error propagation between agents, and unforeseen emergent behaviors.

To address these challenges, cybersecurity must also become autonomous, capable of detecting, isolating, deciding, correcting, and continuously adapting.

The true challenge is no longer to keep humans inside every loop, but to design autonomous systems whose loops remain governable, explainable, and trustworthy.

It is this agentic vertigo that the INCYBER Forum Europe 2027 invites the world to explore.

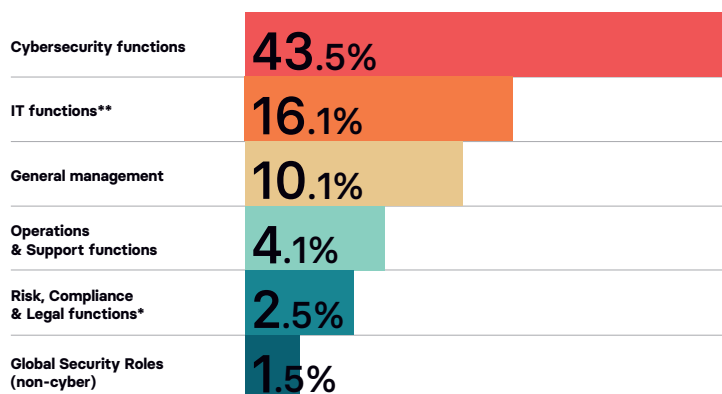
